- Use only # 2 pencils on answer sheet.
- Mark answers on both question sheet and answer sheet.
- Mark **only one** answer for each question.
- There may be more than one correct answer.
- Some answers are incomplete and worth partial credit.
- Show all work on back sides of question sheets.

- You may ask for some standard integrals.
- If you feel the correct answer is not one of the choices, choose "none of the above" and show work for the answer you think is correct.
